

Check a Smoke Alarm Test Reminder

Developing: read a reminder and choose a safe next step



A building posts this routine reminder: Test the smoke alarm on the first Saturday of each month. If the alarm does not work, tell building staff or a trusted support person. Do not take the alarm apart.

Reminder	Test the smoke alarm on the first Saturday of each month.
If it works	The routine check is finished.
If it does not work	Tell building staff or a trusted support person.
Do not	Take the alarm apart or try to repair it yourself.

Sample answers below. Accept equivalent wording and supported communication.

1. When is the routine test scheduled?

The first Saturday of each month.

2. What should someone do if the alarm does not work?

Tell building staff or a trusted support person.

3. Should someone take the alarm apart?

No.

4. Write or say a short report for staff.

Example: The smoke alarm did not work during the routine test. Please check it.
