Developing: subtraction within 30



A fictional craft studio requires a deposit. A deposit is part of the full price, paid early. Prices include all fees.

Full class price	\$28.00
Deposit already paid	\$10.00
Pay the rest	At the studio on class day
Money brought to class	\$20.00

Read the information. Write, say, point to, or dictate your answers. A calculator may be used.

1. How much has already been paid?

2. How much is still owed on class day?

3. Is \$20 enough to pay the rest?

4. How much change should the learner receive from \$20?

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Sample answers below. Accept equivalent wording and supported communication.

1. How much has already been paid?

\$10.00.

2. How much is still owed on class day?

\$18.00 (\$28.00 - \$10.00).

3. Is \$20 enough to pay the rest?

Yes; \$20.00 is at least \$18.00.

4. How much change should the learner receive from \$20?

\$2.00 (\$20.00 - \$18.00).
