Follow a Changing-Room Privacy Routine

Foundational: apply posted rules



Read this fictional pool changing-room notice. A learner may use a support person according to their own needs and choices.

Choose a space	Use an empty changing cubicle.
Before entering	If a door is closed, knock and wait for a reply.
While changing	Close the cubicle door for privacy.
If help is needed	Ask your chosen support person or pool staff.
Phones	No photos or videos in the changing area.
