1 / The fall savings jar

3 quarters, 3 dimes, 3 nickels, 3 pennies. 12 coins altogether. Total: $75 + 30 + 15 + 3 = 123$ cents (\$1.23). Coins are clearly labeled practice symbols; use real coins alongside the sheet when teaching visual coin identification.

2 / At the autumn market

Apple: 35 cents, YES. Pumpkin: 60 cents, NOT YET; 15 cents more is needed. Basket: 80 cents, YES. Count aloud or use a calculator. For extra practice, show 15 cents using a dime and nickel, or three nickels.

3-4 / Autumn letter and word trails

Each page has six picture words: apple, pumpkin, leaf, scarf, basket, acorn. Page 3: trace the dotted initial letter pairs and words, then try the letter pairs. Page 4: trace each dotted word and write it in the blank guides. These pages practice selected picture-linked letters, not the whole alphabet.

5-6 / Count the harvest

Page 5 groups: 0, 1, 2, 3, 4 apples. Page 6 groups: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 acorns. Count each picture once, trace each numeral twice, and write it in the blank guide. For zero, the group is empty.

7 / Autumn missing letters

apple: p, l. pumpkin: u, k. acorn: c, r. leaf: e, f. scarf: c, r. basket: a, e. Missing letters are listed from left to right. The word bank can stay visible or be covered for a harder version.

8 / Optional Halloween word hunt

pumpkin: u, k. bat: a. candy: a, y. The carved pumpkin is named pumpkin in this activity. The back-page drawing or description is open-ended; there is no single correct choice.

Ways to participate

Accept pointing, speaking, signing, typing, or a communication device. Offer a pencil grip, larger writing paper, or a partner to record responses as needed. A learner can identify a letter or number even when handwriting is difficult. No timers or speed scores are needed.

Seasonal design

This edition uses autumn themes for September and October in the northeastern United States. The Halloween page is optional and can be left out. Keep autumn pages available for learners who prefer seasonal activities without a holiday theme.
