

Decline an Invitation - Level 2

Level 2: compose a reply and maintain a boundary



Taylor invites Morgan to a loud concert. Morgan does not want to go. Morgan would enjoy a quiet cafe another day. A person may decline without giving a reason.

Invitation	Would you like to go to the concert Friday?
Morgan's choice	No concert. A cafe visit is optional.
If asked again	Morgan can repeat the choice clearly.
Respectful response	Accept the answer without pressure.

Sample answers below. Accept equivalent wording and supported communication.

1. Write or say a clear way Morgan can decline.

Example: No thank you. I do not want to go.

2. Write an optional alternative Morgan could suggest.

Example: Would you like to visit a quiet cafe another day?

3. Taylor asks again. What can Morgan say?

Example: My answer is still no.

4. What is a respectful reply from Taylor?

Example: Okay, thanks for telling me.
